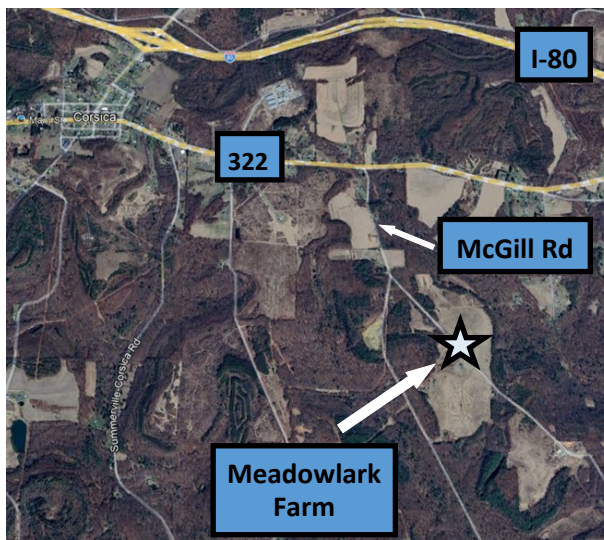

Steve is a lifelong cattleman and regenerative livestock consultant based in Idaho. With decades of hands-on experience, Steve helps producers improve fertility, efficiency, and profitability using practical, low-cost strategies grounded in animal observation, mineral balance, soil health, genetic and epigenetic selection.

He has presented at leading conferences including Acres U.S.A. Eco-Ag Conference, GrassWorks Grazing Conference, National Grazing Lands Conference, and consults with producers across North America.
